OUR CATHOLIC WOMEN'S LEAGUE WAS BORN FOR SOCIAL JUSTICE!

The first council founded in Edmonton in 1912 was affiliated with The Catholic Women's League of England and its main purpose was to address the needs of immigrant women and children. The Catholic Women's League of Canada was then established in 1920 with a main concern for the needs of immigrants. In CWL National's online "Powerful Stories from the First 100 Years", one video says "... she's a mother and a fighter, a woman of faith and also a woman of action. She uses her voice to stand up for others and her prayers to bring change to the world... she has many friends and sisters... She is The Catholic Women's League of Canada ". And another: "... a single voice can create change and, joined by thousands more, it can change the world ". Amidst all we do for Social Justice, our hearts still overflow with needs for social change!

WORLD UNION OF CATHOLIC WOMEN'S ORGANIZATIONS (WUCWO)

The North American WUCWO Conference was held on the Sunday of our National Convention and was dedicated to international social justice interventions taken by WUCWO. We were challenged to propose an intervention for North America along with supportive funding ideas.
