

**What is the Vancouver Archdiocesan League Development Fund (LDF)?**

The LDF was established from funds returned to the Vancouver Archdiocesan Catholic Women's League after the 2005 National Convention held in Vancouver.

Members decided by a motion that the funds should be made available to promote and build the League and as well as train and develop members as leaders.

**How are the funds to be used?**

- The funds are to be used for the education and development of members as a group.
- To enable training to be offered by the League Development Team, diocesan or provincial officers or other qualified guest speakers.
- To coordinate and organize programs to promote the objectives of the League.
- To be used for regional or parish council workshops.
- To be used where one or more councils would benefit as well as potential League members.
- To enable the League Development Team to promote the League in the Archdiocese.
- To enable the League Development Team to work with parish councils on membership recruitment and to nurture parish councils.

**How often can we apply for LDF?**

- A council may apply for LDF once a year.
